

An “Extension” of the Sunday of Orthodoxy

Informational Presentation in Northern Greece

ON THE SUNDAY of the Veneration of the Cross, 21 March 2005 (Old Style), with the blessing of His Eminence, Metropolitan Cyprian, our Parish of the Holy Twelve Apostles in Kymina, Thessaloniki, organized

an informational presentation in the assembly hall of the nearby municipality of Axion with the general title:

“1965-2005: Steps Towards the Consolidation of the Heresy of Ecumenism.”

This presentation was essentially a repetition, in abbreviated form, of the similarly-titled, important, and timely presentation held on the Sunday of Orthodoxy, which was organized by the Holy Monastery of Sts. Cyprian and Justina (Fili, Attika) at the Novotel in Athens on 7 March 2005



(Old Style) as the “Thirteenth Convocation for Orthodox Awareness.”

The talk at the presentation in Thessaloniki was given, in two parts, by Archimandrite Glykerios Agiokyprianites, and a special videotape was shown (45 minutes), which demonstrated the obvious and progressive estrangement of the Orthodox ecumenists from the Tradition of the Fathers.

Master of Ceremonies was Chanter Nicholas Polychros.

In attendance were the Priest of our parish in Katerini, Father Vitalios Almanides, and a good number of the Faithful from our parishes in Greek Macedonia (Thessaloniki, Kymina, Katerini, Ptolemais), as well as other people interested in the topic.
