The following letter was sent by the Hierarchs of the American Exarchate of the Holy Synod in Resistance of the Old Calendar Orthodox Church of Greece to His Eminence, Bishop Photii, First Hierarch of the Old Calendar Orthodox Church of Bulgaria, on the occasion of the Consecration of the Cathedral of the Dormition of the Mother of God, in Sofia, on the Feast of St. Pachomios the Great, May 15, 2011 (Old Style). The newly Consecrated Cathedral is one of the larger Orthodox Churches in Bulgaria and has become a landmark in the country's capital city, since its recent completion.
