


Father Michael Nedelsky Retires from Teaching Post

AT THE END OF THE SPRING TERM, 2011, the Reverend Dr. Michael Nedelsky, who has a small house Church and mission dedicat-



ed to St. Seraphim of Sarov in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, under the jurisdiction of the American Exarchate of our Church, retired from Augustana College, also in Sioux Falls, where he was a Professor of Psychology. Father Michael, who received his doctoral degree from the University of Chicago, taught Abnormal Psychology, Psychological Measurement and Diagnosis, Drugs and Mental Health, and General Psychology at Augustana for many years. His wife, Presbytera Barbara, also taught French, German, and Russian at Augustana from 1991 to 2008.

Father Michael comes from a family of academics. His Father, Dr. Leo Nedelsky, a student of Dr. Robert Oppenheimer, the father of the atomic bomb, was a Professor of Physics at the University of Chicago. His sister, a multidisciplinary scholar, taught at Princeton for several years and is now a professor in multiple faculties at the University of Toronto.
